- One last interesting fact is that every verse of this song has exactly the same melody as the chorus (this makes it very easy to learn).

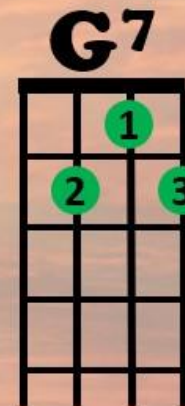
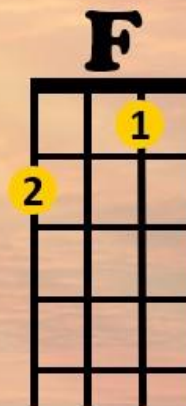
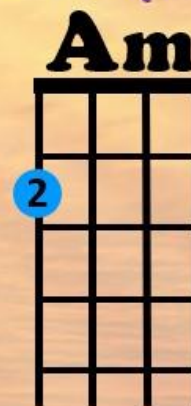
